1<sup>st</sup> Allied Infantry Brigade  
Sterling, VA, 20 November 1944

1. Under the provisions established by the 1<sup>st</sup> Allied Infantry Brigade, the following will be used in the establishing the guidelines for RULES OF ENGAGEMENT for the Allied fighting forces at the Battle of the Bulge Commemoration held at Indiantown Gap Military Reservation.
  - (a) When a Crew Served weapon fires upon an unarmored target, the unarmored target will take a hit.
  - (b) No weapon discharge into ANY vehicle.
  - (c) No projectiles will be thrown, tossed, placed on any vehicle.
  - (d) Vehicle commanders and/or drivers must attend vehicle safety class.
  - (e) No Allied period vehicle will be allowed into the training area without a Vehicle Decal. Brigade HQ will issue these decals at the Vehicle Safety meetings starting on Wednesday - (Brigade GO 1).
  - (f) Only three vehicles per allied company will be allowed into the training area on Saturday. Brigade Headquarters must approve ANY exemption by 2100 hours Friday. The only person to authorize the exception will be the American Commander or his designated representative.
  - (g) No obstacles will be placed across any roads/tank trails in the training area.
    - (1) EXCEPTION - Engineers can use orange surveyor tape across the road/tank trails to signify impassable obstacle by vehicles. Two parallel strips crisscrossed by a single strip is the acceptable method of identifying the obstruction.
    - (2) Other approved method by Brigade Headquarters.
