

1. Under the provisions established by the War Department General Order No. 2 and 1st Allied Infantry Brigade (1AIB), the following General Order will be used to establish the Provost Office and the Positions within the Provost Office for Battle of the Bulge Commemoration held at the Indiantown Gap Military Reservation.
2. The Provost Office will contain two positions.
  - (a) The Provost Marshal (PM).
  - (b) The Assistant Provost Marshal (APM).
3. Captain Peter Ness (Canadian Provost Corps) is appointed the Officer Commanding.
4. Lt Mike Phumphrey (4<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division, Military Police) is appointed the Assistant Provost Officer.
5. Provost Office is established for the purpose of Maintenance of order and discipline in the Area 12.
  - (a) Patrol of the barracks, Flea Market and parking areas.
  - (b) Provide guards as required by 1AIB.
  - (c) Post sentries at road entrances to Area 12, to check registration and ID of reenactors entering the area and to deny access to those who do not have proper credentials.
  - (d) Provide traffic direction and route recon for field tactical exercises.
  - (e) Post sentries at vital points along the convoy route.
  - (f) Provide information to reenactors.
  - (g) Additional duties as assigned by the War Office or 1AIB.
4. The PM is charged with commanding the Provost Office and insuring all duties of the Provost Office are carried out.
5. The APM is charged with the administrative and logistical duties of the Provost Office and to fill the PM position should the PM be disabled or otherwise unavailable and any other duties as assigned by the PM.
6. During The Field Tactical Events the Provost Office will be divided into two sections. No.1 Section will be commanded by the PM and is responsible for the orderly loading of buses and to assist No.2 Section. No.2 Section will be commanded by the APM and is responsible for the orderly formation of the convoy in the Area 12 Motor Pool and the sentries along the convoy route and to assist No.1 section.
